## WHO WE ARE

The Nyack Library was chartered by the State of New York in 1890. The Carnegie Building opened in 1904 and it is the last Carnegie Building in Rockland County.



The Library is a unique blend of the traditional and the modern, both in building design and approach to the service it provides to its community.

The Board of Trustees and dedicated Nyack Library staff provide service to the local community that is both educational and inspirational.



## WHAT WE DO

The Nyack Library lent out 98,587 items for adults in 2016, and 44,432 items for children along with 10,458 electronic materials.



There were 323 programs for adults in 2017, including concerts, lectures and movies. Attendance was 5,006.

1,198 teens attended 147 teen programs. Programs included creative writing, SAT prep and computer programming.



For children, the Library held 458 programs and 7,952 flocked to those events, including baby and toddler programs, Summer Reading events, book groups, crafts and story times.
