Statement of the Library Director



I joined the Nyack Library in May following the retirement of Library Director, Jane Marino, who served in the position for six years. Highlights of FY2019, for the period of July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019 included the renovation of the Circulation Department staff office area and the negotiation of the first labor agreement between the employees represented by the Nyack Library Staff Association and the Library. We added RFID gates to the entrances and presented 9 Carnegie Concerts. Staff attended library conferences and workshops sponsored by the Library Association of Rockland County and the New York Library Association. The Library offered almost 1,000 programs for adults, teens and children that were attended by over 16,000 people. With a grant award from the American Library Association, we offered the American Creed program to explore citizenship and the importance of civil civic engagement. Another memorable Fall program was “The Ghosts of Nyack” when audience members conducted a “ghost hunt”, but found none in the stacks.
