Statement of the Library Director



The first nine months of FY 2020 brought good news and awards to the Nyack Library. The Library received the Ramapo Catskill Library System Annual Program of the Year award for its long term commitment to supporting the performing arts through the Carnegie Concert Series. The Library was also awarded an ArtsWestchester grant to support the *Black Culture and Arts Series: the Legacy of Toni Morrison*. Conceived as an opportunity to highlight and explore the contributions of Black Americans to arts, culture and local history, following the death of Dr. Morrison, the program became a tribute to her legacy. We collaborated with local organizations to develop and offer almost 20 programs within the series.

Without a doubt the final three months of fiscal year proved extremely challenging as we strived to maintain library services in the face of COVID closures. The staff did an extraordinary job creating the "Staying Sane while Staying Home" and virtual meeting programs. Use of our digital resources increased significantly as we did all we could to serve beyond our walls.
